Pair of Chinese rouge-de-fer moulded shell-shaped dishes, Kangxi (1662-1722), decorated in predominantly iron-red enamel with blue and gilt, painted with a central floral roundel and stems including chrysanthemum and lily, all within a geometric flowerhead band to the rims.

Dimensions:

Diameter: 20 cm. (7 7/8in.),

Condition: One with crack, the other broken in four pieces and neatly held together with rivets

<b>Material and Technique</b>	Porcelain with underglaze blue, overglaze enamel and gilt decoration in the Imari palette
<b>Origin</b>	Chinese
<b>Period</b>	18th Century
<b>Condition</b>	Consistent with age
