Diameter: 11.2cm. (4 3/8in.)

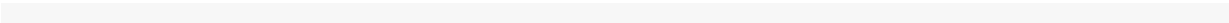
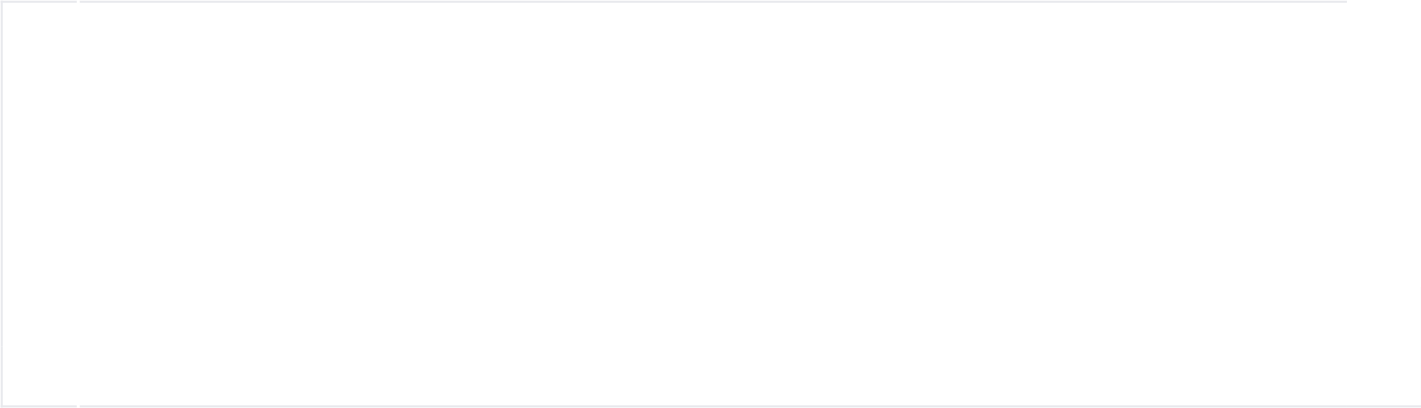
Condition:
