An ancient gold ring set with an amethyst intaglio of Mars Gradivus.

The intaglio measures 1.4 x 1cm.

Weighs 4.9 grams.

The intaglio is set within its original hollow gold ring which has wear and tear, small holes and dents however it remains solid and completely wearable.

The intaglio is engraved with the god of war who can be seen striding to the left; he carries a spear with one hand and with the other he rests a trophy upon his shoulder.

A similar burnt agate intaglio can be found in the collection of the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston, Accession number; 65.627.
