
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Renaissance gold ring with a hessonite garnet. Western Europe, 16th century.

A Renaissance gold ring set with a table cut hessonite garnet.

Western Europe, second half of the 16th century.

Ring Size U UK / 10 US.

The bezel measures 1.3 x 1cm.

The ring weighs 7.1 grams.

There is a very small chip to one of the facets of the garnet.

A similar example was offered by Sotheby's, New Bond Street, European Sculpture and Works of Art, 4th December 2013, Lot 60. It is catalogued as: Finger Ring, gold, with a scalloped bezel set with an oval garnet. Probably Italian, late 16th/ early 17th century.
