The ring is set with a garnet centre of approximately 0.75 carat and seed pearls surrounding it. The ring is crafted of 15k yellow gold and the hands themselves are not clasped but they clasp a central flower. The flower is made of a cluster of 12 seed pearls around a central garnet.

Fede rings, derived from the Italian "mani in fede" meaning "hands in faith," are a significant symbol in jewelry. They feature two clasped hands, representing loyalty, faith, and the unbreakable bond between two people. Historically, these rings were used in medieval and Renaissance Europe as betrothal and wedding rings, symbolizing a promise of love and fidelity. The design, with hands joined in a handshake, conveys a deep trust and mutual respect, making fede rings enduring symbols of commitment and unity in relationships.
