He began his career studying artand goldsmithing in Melbourne before winning a scholarship to study at the Royal College of Art in London. This move marked the beginning of his international acclaim.

In 1965, Devlin established his own studio in London, where he quickly gained a reputation for his distinctive and modern approach to silver and gold design. He became known for his intricate, textured surfaces and inventive forms, often drawing inspiration from nature and mythology. His work included a wide range of items, from jewellery and silverware to large-scale commissions and ceremonial pieces.
