Pair of Chinese famille rose candlesticks, late 18th century, each decorated with small floral sprays and bands of iron red and gilt beneath a curled gilt band to the rims, the lower bodies with stiff leaves in blue and green, the spreading octagonal feet decorated with floral sprays and further curling gilt band

Condition: One broken and neatly restored

The shape is derived from European models made of silver or porcelain.
