



Chinese famille rose teabowl and saucer, Yongzheng (1723-35) POA

Chinese famille rose teabowl and saucer, Yongzheng (1723-35), with gently barbed rims, decorated with alternating panels of peony and landscapes with pine trees and rockwork, all contained within bands of scrolling pink ground; the interior of the teabowl with a band of geometric zig-zag pattern to the rim and central floral spray, the saucer with a central roundel containing peonies, seedpods and foliage, the reverse with three lingzhi in iron red.

Dimensions:

Diameter of teabowl: 6.6cm. (2 5/8in.); diameter of saucer: 11.4cm. (4 7/16in.)

Condition:

Frits to teabowl and innerglaze crack, saucer with firing crack to the reverse
