Antique Edwardian Gold Ring with Pearl and Old-Cut Diamonds (Circa 1910)

This elegant Edwardian-era three-stone ring, crafted around 1910, features a natural freshwater pearl at its centre, measuring 5 mm in diameter, flanked by two old round-cut diamonds. The diamonds, each weighing approximately 0.15 carats, offer a total carat weight of 0.30 carats. Their clarity (SI1) and near-colourless grade (F-G) add a brilliant sparkle that complements the soft lustre of the pearl.

The flowing design of the setting creates a graceful and feminine aesthetic, characteristic of Edwardian jewellery. The gold band, tested as 12K, adds a warm touch to this classic piece, making it both an elegant accessory and a collector's treasure.
