The centerpiece is a black intaglio stone, intricately engraved with the Lubich clan coat of arms. The coat of arms features a crowned crest with three ostrich feathers, symbolizing nobility, peace, and strength. The shield beneath the crest contains detailed heraldic elements, reflecting the rich heritage of the Lubich family. The thick, polished gold shank tapers gently, ensuring both a bold design and comfortable fit.

The Lubich coat of arms is rooted in the Polish-Lithuanian Szlachta (nobility), known for their influence in military and political affairs. Heraldic symbols such as the ostrich feathers signify noble lineage and were often passed down through generations as a mark of family pride.
