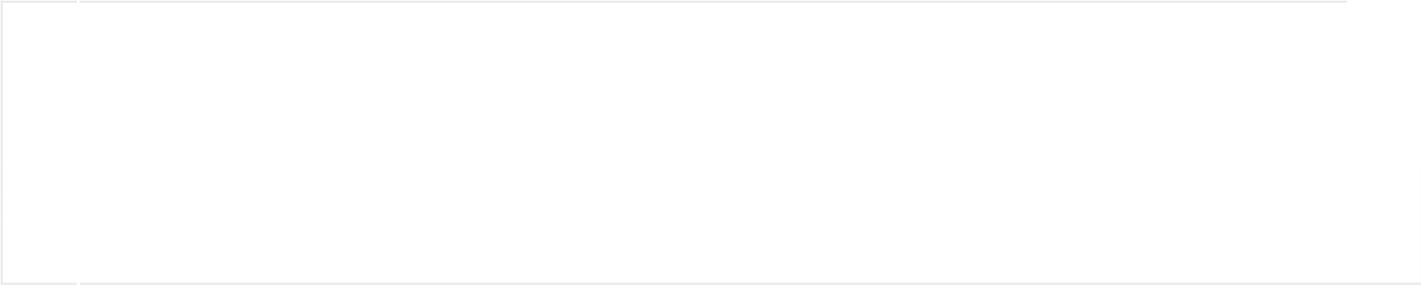
Condition: haircrack to upper body neatly restored.
