Chinese famille verte dish, Shunzhi (circa 1650-60), decorated in the centre with a fenghua (phoenix) and a qilin in a garden setting within ruyi-shaped bands, the cavetto with a band of diaper, the rim with foliate peony scrolls, the reverse with flower sprays and lappets to the base with a double footrim, old Chinese collector's mark to base; diameter: 13 ¼ in. (34cm.), condition: fritting to rim
