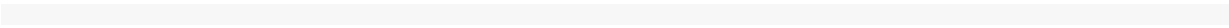


**Edwardian Diamond Pearl Pendant in Platinum date circa 1905, SHAPIRO & Co since 1979

Q: When was the Edwardian Jewellery Period?

A: King Edward VII, after whom this period of jewellery history is named, reigned over England for only nine years, yet the style of jewellery known as “Edwardian” was created roughly between 1901 and 1910.
